

BLACK AND WHITE PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION 2017

1. PARTICIPANTS

Any photographer who has turned 18 years of age before the 18th of February, 2017, professional or armature may participate.

2. THEME

All photographs must be in black and white.

3. ENTERING PHOTOGRAPHS

A.) Every photographer may present up to two photographs. Files must be sent by wettransfer to contest@thewetprint.com. **Photographs sent directly via email will not be accepted.** Minimum size of the photograph is 2000 pixels on the short side. The name of the file must be the same as the title of the work indicated in the participation form.

B.) The participant must fill out the participation form at www.thewetprint.com/contest

C.) Photographs which have been awarded in other contests are allowed. Photo manipulation is also allowed.

D.) There is no participation fee

E.) The participant keeps all rights to the photograph.

F.) All files, except the two winning photographs, will be erased one week after the end of the contest. The files for the winning photographs will be erased after printing.

4. TIMELINE

All photos must be submitted before midnight on the 28th of February, 2017. The winning photographers will be notified before the 6th of March, 2017 and their names will be published at www.thewetprint.com/contest on the 7th of March, 2017.

5. EVALUATION AND PRIZES

The photographs will be scored on creativity, quality of the file/image, technical aspects, emotion of the image, and difficulty or work put into making the photograph.

1st Prize: A 16x20" carbon transfer print of the participant's photograph sent to their door. \$480 value.

2nd Prize: A 8x10" carbon transfer print of the participant's photograph sent to their door. \$180 value.

6. EXPOSITION

The winning photographs will be printing using the carbon transfer process. Photos of

those prints will be shown at www.thewetprint.com, www.instagram.com/thewetprint and <https://500px.com/calvingrier> with links to the photographer's websites.

7. DELIVERY OF PRIZES

Once the photographs are printed, they will be packaged and sent to the winning photographers.

8. ORGANIZER
